the terms of all current members of judicial nominating commissions; providing for staggered terms of newly appointed members; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 43.291, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
 - 43.291 Judicial nominating commissions.-
- (3) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, each current member of a judicial nominating commission appointed directly by the Board of Governors of The Florida Bar shall serve the remainder of his or her term, unless removed for cause. The terms of all current other members of a judicial nominating commission are hereby terminated, and the Governor shall appoint new members to each judicial nominating commission in the following manner:
- (a) Two appointments for terms ending July 1, $\underline{2012}$ $\underline{2002}$, one of which shall be an appointment selected from nominations submitted by the Board of Governors of The Florida Bar pursuant to paragraph (1)(a);
- (b) Two appointments for terms ending July 1, $\underline{2013}$ $\underline{2003}$; and
 - (c) Two appointments for terms ending July 1, 2014 2004.

the member whose position is being filled.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
