Senator Jones moved the following:

## Senate Amendment

Delete lines 74 - 96 and insert:

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(g) The organization shall adopt bylaws or policies that require student athletes who are suspected of sustaining a concussion or head injury in a practice or competition to be immediately removed from the activity. A student athlete who has been removed may not return to practice or competition until the student receives written clearance to return from a physician licensed under chapter 458 or chapter 459 who is certified by the American Board of Neurological Surgery or the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery, certified in Orthopaedic Sports Medicine

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by the American Board of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, certified in Neuromuscular Medicine, Spinal Cord Injury Medicine, or Sports Medicine by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology, certified in Clinical Neurophysiology, Neurodevelopmental Disabilities, or Neuromuscular Medicine, or a physician licensed under chapter 460 who is certified by the Academy of Chiropractic Orthopedists, the American Board of Chiropractic Orthopedics, or the American Chiropractic Neurology Board, or certified as a chiropractic sports physician. The written clearance must state that the student athlete no longer exhibits signs, symptoms, or behaviors consistent with a concussion or other head injury. Before issuing a written clearance to return to practice or competition, a physician may:

- 1. Delegate the performance of medical acts to a health care practitioner licensed or certified under s. 458.347, s. 459.022, s. 464.012, or s. 468.707 with whom the physician maintains a formal supervisory relationship or an established written protocol that identifies the medical acts or evaluations to be performed and conditions for their performance and that attests to proficiency in the evaluation and management of concussions.
- 2. Consult with, or utilize testing and evaluation of cognitive functions performed by, a neuropsychologist licensed under chapter 490.
