An act relating to frozen desserts; repealing chapter 503, F.S., relating to the state's regulation of frozen desserts, enforcement and penalties for violations of such regulations, licensure of frozen dessert plants, and preemption of municipal and county regulations of frozen desserts; amending ss. 381.0014, 570.07, 570.40, 570.41, 570.50, and 570.51, F.S.; to conform; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. <u>Chapter 503, Florida Statutes, consisting of</u> sections 503.011, 503.021, 503.031, 503.041, 503.0415, 503.051, 503.071, 503.081, and 503.091, is repealed.

Section 2. Section 381.0014, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

381.0014 Regulations and ordinances superseded.—The rules adopted by the department under the provisions of this chapter shall, as to matters of public health, supersede all rules enacted by other state departments, boards or commissions, or ordinances and regulations enacted by municipalities, except that this chapter does not alter or supersede any of the provisions set forth in chapters 502 and 503 or any rule adopted under the authority of that chapter those-chapters.

Section 3. Paragraph (m) of subsection (16) and subsection (19) of section 570.07, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

570.07 Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services;

functions, powers, and duties.—The department shall have and exercise the following functions, powers, and duties:

- (16) To enforce the state laws and rules relating to:
- (m) Administration and enforcement of all regulatory legislation applying to milk, and milk products, and ice cream, and frozen desserts;

In order to ensure uniform health and safety standards, the adoption of standards and fines in the subject areas of paragraphs (a)-(n) is expressly preempted to the state and the department. Any local government enforcing the subject areas of paragraphs (a)-(n) must use the standards and fines set forth in the pertinent statutes or any rules adopted by the department pursuant to those statutes.

(19) To protect the dairy interests of the state; and, to that end, it shall enforce those functions, powers, and duties given to it in <u>chapter</u> chapters 502 and 503.

Section 4. Subsection (2) of section 570.40, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

570.40 Division of Dairy Industry; powers and duties.—The duties of the Division of Dairy Industry include, but are not limited to:

(2) Inspecting milk plants and milk product plants, and plants engaged in the manufacture and distribution of frozen desserts and frozen desserts mix; analyzing and testing samples of milk and milk products, frozen desserts, and frozen desserts mix collected by it; and enforcing those provisions of chapter chapters 502 and 503 as are authorized by the department.

- Section 6. Subsections (2) and (3) of section 570.50, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:
- 570.50 Division of Food Safety; powers and duties.—The duties of the Division of Food Safety include, but are not limited to:
- (2) Conducting those general inspection activities relating to food and food products being processed, held, or offered for sale in this state and enforcing those provisions of chapters 500, 501, 502, 503, 531, 583, 585, 586, and 601 relating to foods as authorized by the department.
- (3) Analyzing samples of foods offered for sale in this state as required under chapters 500, 501, 502, $\frac{503}{7}$, 585, 586, and 601.
- Section 7. Subsection (2) of section 570.51, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
 - 570.51 Director; qualifications; duties.-
- (2) The director shall supervise, direct, and coordinate the activities of the division and enforce the provisions of chapters 500, 501, 502, $\frac{503}{7}$, 531, 583, 585, and 601 and any other chapter necessary to carry out the responsibilities of the division.
