An act relating to taxi operators; authorizing governmental units that regulate the operation of taxis to create a private property right in the license to operate a taxi; providing for the transfer of such property right; providing definitions; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. (1) Any governmental unit that is authorized to regulate the operation of taxis within its geographic boundaries may adopt ordinances, rules, regulations, orders, or other acts that create a private property right or interest in a license to operate a taxi within the geographic boundaries of the governmental unit.
- (2) Upon the creation of such private property right, the owner of a taxi operation may pledge, sell, assign, sublease, or otherwise transfer the license to another person. However, the owner must apply to the governmental unit before making such transfer and obtain its approval for the proposed action, except that a license may be transferred by operation of intestate succession or devise.
 - (3) As used in this section, the term:
- (a) "License" includes any certificate, permit, medallion, or other evidence that authorizes a person to operate a taxi within the geographic boundaries of a governmental unit.
- (b) "Governmental unit" includes a county, municipality, special district, commission, or other unit of state or local
