WHEREAS, in remembrance of the many men who have lost their lives to breast cancer, and in support of those who are currently fighting this often overlooked disease, every citizen, whether male or female, including parents, siblings, spouses, educators, and physicians, is encouraged to take part in spreading awareness of male breast cancer, NOW, THEREFORE,
