Effective October 1, 2012, passage of an examination approved administered by the department which measures the 31 32 applicant's competency and proficiency in the subject material of the public safety telecommunication training program. 33 If a person was employed as a 911 public safety 34 (j) telecommunicator, a sworn state-certified law enforcement 35 36 officer, or a state-certified firefighter before April 1, 2012, 37 he or she must pass the examination approved administered by the 38 department which measures the competency and proficiency in the 39 subject material of the public safety telecommunication program, as defined in paragraph (1)(c).
