23	(2) In order to promote public health and safety:
24	(b) Any person or entity in possession of an automated
25	external defibrillator is encouraged to notify the local
26	emergency medical services medical director <u>or the local public</u>
27	safety answering point, as defined in s. 365.172(3)(a), of the
28	location of the automated external defibrillator.

30	telecommunicator, as defined in s. 401.465, may contact any
