> A bill to be entitled An act relating to Broward County; authorizing the Broward County School Board to include an honors course in ethics in its high school curriculum; providing that a student may receive credit as an elective upon successful completion of the course; providing for course content; requiring the Broward County School Board to prescribe performance standards and assessment requirements for the course; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) The Broward County School Board may include an honors course in ethics in its high school curriculum. A student who successfully completes the honors course in ethics may receive credit for the course as an elective for high school graduation.
(2) The content of the honors course in ethics shall be aligned with the Next Generation Sunshine State Standards and may include, but is not limited to:
(a) The major ethical philosophers and ethical theories in history and their application to current ethical issues.
(b) The examination of ethical concepts and problems, including the types of arguments concerning ethical issues.
(c) The tools necessary to analyze and evaluate current ethical issues and formulate a personal value system, with emphasis on character education.
(3) The Broward County School Board shall prescribe performance standards and assessment requirements for the honors course in ethics.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
