Section 1. Section 1012.81, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1012.81 Personnel records.—Rules of the State Board of Education shall prescribe the content and custody of limitedaccess records that which a Florida College System institution may maintain on its employees. The $\frac{Such}{c}$ records $\frac{must}{c}$ $\frac{shall}{c}$ be limited to information reflecting evaluations of employee performance and may shall be open to inspection only by the employee and by officials of the college who are responsible for supervision of the employee. Such Limited-access employee records are confidential and exempt from the provisions of s. 119.07(1); however, records relating to a performance evaluation of a president of a Florida College System institution are not confidential and exempt from the provisions of s. 119.07(1). Except as required for use by the president in the discharge of his or her official responsibilities, the custodian of limitedaccess employee records may release information from the such records only upon authorization in writing from the employee or
