22	(b) <del>By October 1, 2004,</del> The Department of Education, with
23	the assistance of <del>the</del> school districts, shall select a common
24	student assessment instrument and protocol for measuring student
25	learning gains and student progression while a student is in a
26	juvenile justice education program. The assessment instrument
27	and protocol must be implemented in all juvenile justice
28	education programs in this state <del>by January 1, 2005</del> . <u>The</u>
29	Department of Education shall submit to the Legislature an

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30	annual status report that includes the results of the assessment
31	for measuring student learning gains and student progression and
32	details the methodology used by the department to ensure that
33	student performance data is complete and reliable.
