HB 295 2012

A bill to be entitled

An act relating to contracts for rail projects; requiring an entity that applies for a rail project to contract with the Department of Transportation, an agency or instrumentality of the state, or a local governmental entity to certify involvement or noninvolvement with deportation of individuals to extermination camps or death camps during a specified timeframe; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Any entity that applies for a contract with the Department of Transportation, an agency or instrumentality of the state, or a local governmental entity for any rail project, including, but not limited to, the design, engineering, construction, manufacture, or operation of a rail network or any components thereof, that is partially or fully publicly funded shall, in advance of submitting the bid, certify to the department, agency or instrumentality of the state, or local governmental entity as to whether such entity had any direct involvement in the deportation of any individual to an extermination camp or death camp, or to any facility used for the purpose of transiting individuals to extermination camps or death camps, during the period beginning on January 1, 1939, and ending on December 31, 1944.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
