Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Paragraph (i) is added to subsection (1) of section 957.04, Florida Statutes, to read:
  - 957.04 Contract requirements.-
- (1) A contract entered into under this chapter for the operation of private correctional facilities shall maximize the cost savings of such facilities and shall:
- (i) Require that the contractor provide, at a minimum, the following services at designated visiting areas for approved visitors in the private correctional facility:
- 1. Information relating to applicable visiting regulations, dress codes for visitors, and visiting procedures.
- 2. A sheltered area, outside the security perimeter, where visitors may wait before and after visiting inmates.
- 3. Food services, including foods that are nutritious and acceptable for children and youth visitors.
- 4. Minimal equipment and supplies that assist staff and visitors in managing and occupying the time and meeting the needs of children and youth visitors.
  - Section 2. This act applies to contracts entered into,
