Providing training to school readiness providers and parents on child performance standards, child screenings, child assessments, developmentally appropriate curricula, character development, teacher-child interactions, age-appropriate discipline practices, health and safety, nutrition, first aid, the recognition of communicable diseases, and child abuse detection and prevention.
- d. Providing from among the funds provided for the activities described in sub-subparagraphs a.-c. adequate funding of direct services for infants and toddlers as necessary to meet federal requirements related to expenditures for quality activities for infant and toddler care.
- e. Assisting the provider to implement a preassessment and postassessment approved by the Office of Early Learning.
