House Memorial

A memorial to the Congress of the United States, urging Congress to discontinue its practice of imposing federal mandates and legislation upon the states which exceed the scope of its constitutionally delegated powers under the Tenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States and to repeal existing compulsory federal legislation that directs the states to comply or requires the states to pass specific legislation in order not to lose federal funding.

WHEREAS, the people of the State of Florida assert their residual and inviolable sovereignty under the Tenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States over all powers not otherwise enumerated and granted to the Federal Government by that Constitution, and

WHEREAS, the people of the State of Florida also refuse to comply with mandates issued by any branch of the Federal Government which are beyond the scope of such constitutionally delegated powers and demand that the Federal Government cease and desist from issuing mandates that are beyond the scope of such powers, and

WHEREAS, the people of the State of Florida further refuse to recognize or comply with any compulsory federal legislation that directs the state to comply or requires the state to pass specific legislation in order not to lose federal funding, and HM 57 2012

WHEREAS, the sovereignty of the State of Florida is threatened by federal mandates and legislation that exceed the scope of power delegated to the Federal Government under the Tenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the imposition of excessive federal enactments diminishes the rights and abilities of the people of the State of Florida to govern themselves as a free and independent state, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the Congress of the United States is urged to discontinue its current practice of imposing federal mandates and legislation upon the states which exceed the scope of its constitutionally delegated powers under the Tenth Amendment to Constitution of the United States.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Congress is also urged to repeal all existing compulsory federal legislation that directs the states to comply or requires the states to pass specific legislation in order not to lose federal funding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be dispatched to the President of the United States, to the President of the United States Senate, to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, and to each member of the Florida delegation to the United States Congress.
