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Section 6. Road marking materials.-

(1) A county, municipality, local governing authority, or 6 7 other political subdivision of this state may not cause or allow 8 markings to be placed on a street, roadway, or highway under its 9 jurisdiction which are made with paint that has been mixed, in 10 whole or in part, with reflective glass beads that contain 75 11 parts per million or more of inorganic arsenic as determined 12 using EPA Method 6010B in conjunction with EPA Method 3052 for 13 sample preparation.
