Department of Environmental Protection; providing for sources of funds and purposes; providing for annual carryforward of funds; providing for the future review and termination or re-creation of the trust fund; providing a contingent effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 403.7451, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

- 403.7451 Household Pharmaceuticals Collection and Disposal Trust Fund.-
- (1) The Household Pharmaceuticals Collection and Disposal Trust Fund is created within the Department of Environmental Protection and shall be administered by the Secretary of Environmental Protection or his or her designee. Funds credited to the trust fund shall consist of funds received from fees imposed pursuant to s. 938.16.
- (2) The trust fund is established for use as a depository for funds to be used for the purposes of the household pharmaceuticals collection and disposal grant program established in s. 403.745.
- (3) Notwithstanding s. 216.301 and pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of the year and shall

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30	be available for carrying out the purpose of the trust fund.
31	(4) In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State
32	Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be
33	terminated on July 1, 2016. Before its scheduled termination,
34	the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1)
35	and (2).
36	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012, if
37	Senate Bill or similar legislation is adopted in the same
38	legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes law.
