An act relating to enterprise zones; creating s. 290.0079, F.S.; authorizing Polk County, the City of Auburndale, the City of Bartow, the City of Eagle Lake, the City of Fort Meade, the City of Frostproof, the City of Lake Wales, the City of Mulberry, and the City of Polk City to apply, individually or jointly, to the Department of Economic Opportunity for designation of a specified number of enterprise zones; providing application requirements; requiring the department to establish the effective dates of the enterprise zones; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 290.0079, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

290.0079 Enterprise zone designations for Polk County, the City of Auburndale, the City of Bartow, the City of Eagle Lake, the City of Fort Meade, the City of Frostproof, the City of Lake Wales, the City of Mulberry, and the City of Polk City.—The City of Auburndale, the City of Bartow, the City of Eagle Lake, the City of Fort Meade, the City of Frostproof, the City of Lake Wales, the City of Mulberry, and the City of Polk City may apply, individually, jointly with Polk County, or in any combination, to the department for designation of enterprise zones within Polk County. The applications must comply with the requirements of s. 290.0055. The department may designate up to eight enterprise zones, consisting of no more than one

enterprise zone for each city, either individually or in
combination with the county, notwithstanding s. 290.0065

limiting the total number of enterprise zones designated and the
number of enterprise zones within a population category. The
department shall establish the initial effective date of the
enterprise zones under this section.
