Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 465.014, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

465.014 Pharmacy technician.

A person other than a licensed pharmacist or pharmacy intern may not engage in the practice of the profession of pharmacy, except that a licensed pharmacist may delegate to pharmacy technicians who are registered pursuant to this section those duties, tasks, and functions that do not fall within the purview of s. 465.003(13). All such delegated acts shall be performed under the direct supervision of a licensed pharmacist who shall be responsible for all such acts performed by persons under his or her supervision. A pharmacy registered technician, under the supervision of a pharmacist, may initiate or receive communications with a practitioner or his or her agent, on behalf of a patient, regarding refill authorization requests. A licensed pharmacist may not supervise more than six one registered pharmacy technicians technician unless otherwise permitted by the guidelines adopted by the board. The board shall establish quidelines to be followed by licensees or permittees in determining the circumstances under which a

licensed pharmacist may supervise more than one but not more than three pharmacy technicians.
