b. Capable of providing student-level data; however, the department shall remove personally identifiable information from education records of students, or any other information that is confidential pursuant to applicable law. The personally identifiable information must be redacted, aggregated, or otherwise protected by de-identification, anonymization, or any combination thereof. To satisfy confidentiality protections of this section and 20 U.S.C. s. 1232g, also known as the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), the department may

assign an anonymized random identification number to each record before providing access to data. The department shall develop and the State Board of Education shall adopt rules regarding redacting and anonymizing personally identifiable information. Data provided to organizations and authorized representatives pursuant to subsection (4) may not include personally identifiable information regarding a student's or a student's family's juvenile delinquency records, criminal records, medical records, biometric information, religious affiliations or beliefs, political affiliations or beliefs, and sexual behavior or attitudes.
