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29 in the business of electrical or alarm system contracting 30 pursuant to a certificate or registration issued by the 31 department under part II of chapter 489. 32 "Low-voltage alarm system project" means a project (b) 33 related to the installation, maintenance, inspection, 34 replacement, or service of any new or existing alarm system, as 35 defined in s. 489.505, operating at low voltage, as defined in 36 the National Electrical Code Standard 70, Current Edition. 37 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this (3) 38 section applies to low-voltage alarm system projects for which a 39 permit is required by a local enforcement agency. 40 (4) A local enforcement agency shall make uniform basic 41 permit labels available for purchase by a contractor at a cost 42 of not more than \$60 per label. A contractor may purchase labels 43 in bulk for one or more unspecified current or future projects. 44 (a) A local enforcement agency may not require a contractor, as a condition of purchasing a label, to submit any 45 46 information other than identification information and proof of registration or licensure as a contractor. 47 48 (b) A label is valid for 1 year after the date of 49 purchase. 50 (5) A contractor shall post an unused uniform basic permit label in a conspicuous place on the premises of the low-voltage 51 52 alarm system project site before commencing work on a project. 53 (6) A contractor is not required to notify the local 54 enforcement agency before commencing work on a low-voltage alarm 55 system project. However, a contractor must submit a uniform 56 notice of installation of alarm system to the local enforcement

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85 (8) A low-voltage alarm system project may be inspected by 86 the local enforcement agency to ensure compliance with applicable codes and standards. The local enforcement agency 87 88 shall contact the owner of the property where the project was 89 completed to coordinate an inspection. If a low-voltage alarm 90 system project fails an inspection, the contractor must take corrective action as necessary to pass inspection. A new uniform 91 92 basic permit label shall be posted by the contractor after each 93 failed inspection until the project passes inspection. A municipality, county, district, or other entity of 94 (9) 95 local government may not adopt or maintain in effect an 96 ordinance or rule regarding a low-voltage alarm system project 97 that is inconsistent with this section. 98 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
