The Committee on Community Affairs (Simpson) recommended the following:

## Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. Subsection (16) is added to section 633.0215, Florida Statutes, to read:

633.0215 Florida Fire Prevention Code. -

(16) (a) Fire flow requirements may be decreased by the authority that has jurisdiction for isolated buildings or a group of buildings in rural areas or small communities, as defined in the Florida Fire Prevention Code, if that authority determines that the development of full fire flow requirements

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is impractical.

- (b) A business located in a one-story or two-story building that is less than 10,000 square feet is exempt from any 2-hour or longer fire-rated wall requirement and any fire sprinkler requirement in the Florida Fire Prevention Code, including the national codes incorporated by reference.
- (c) A farming or ranching operation that employs fewer than 25 full-time employees and that is not used by the public for direct sales or as an educational outreach facility is exempt from the Florida Fire Prevention Code, including the national codes and Life Safety Code incorporated by reference.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
