(1) There is created the Safe Schools Trust Fund within the department. Funds credited to the trust fund shall consist of the funds deposited under s. 212.20(6)(d) and any other funds as provided by law.

(2) The trust fund balance shall be allocated by the department to school districts governed by this chapter to fund expenses under s. 790.0535, s. 1006.025(4), and, to the extent funds remain, additional projects and programs to improve the safety of students while they are within school safety zones as defined in s. 810.0975.

(3) Notwithstanding s. 216.301 and pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of the year and shall be available for carrying out the purposes of the trust fund.
