Section 3. Subsection (23) is added to section 489.103, Florida Statutes, to read:

489.103 Exemptions.—This part does not apply to:

(23) A volunteer or a person acting out of charity and not for personal monetary or other personal gain who assists a property owner of a single-family residential building and its appurtenances in making improvements to the owner's property. This subsection does not exempt a person who is employed by or



has a contract with the property owner and who acts in the capacity of a contractor. This subsection does not exempt a person who advertises that he or she is a contractor or who otherwise represents that he or she is qualified to engage in contracting. The property owner must be present on the job site and must actively engage in and participate in the supervision of work performed by a volunteer or a person acting out of charity.
