(c)1. The FHSAA shall adopt bylaws that require all 7 students participating in interscholastic athletic competition 8 or who are candidates for an interscholastic athletic team to 9 satisfactorily pass a medical evaluation each year before prior to participating in interscholastic athletic competition or engaging in any practice, tryout, workout, or other physical activity associated with the student's candidacy for an interscholastic athletic team. Such medical evaluation may be administered only by a practitioner licensed under chapter 458, chapter 459, chapter 460, or s. 464.012, and in good standing with the practitioner's regulatory board. The bylaws must shall establish requirements for eliciting a student's medical history and performing the medical evaluation required under this paragraph, which must shall include a physical assessment of the

20 student's physical capabilities to participate in 21 interscholastic athletic competition as contained in a uniform 22 preparticipation physical evaluation and history form. The 23 evaluation form must shall incorporate the recommendations of 24 the American Heart Association for participation cardiovascular 25 screening and must shall provide a place for the signature of 26 the practitioner performing the evaluation with an attestation 27 that each examination procedure listed on the form was performed 28 by the practitioner or by someone under the direct supervision 29 of the practitioner. The form must shall also contain a place for the practitioner to indicate if a referral to another 30 31 practitioner was made in lieu of completion of a certain 32 examination procedure. The form must shall provide a place for 33 the practitioner to whom the student was referred to complete 34 the remaining sections and attest to that portion of the 35 examination. The preparticipation physical evaluation form must shall advise students to complete a cardiovascular assessment 36 and must shall include information concerning alternative 37 38 cardiovascular evaluation and diagnostic tests. Results of such 39 medical evaluation must be provided to the school. No student 40 shall be eligible to participate in any interscholastic athletic 41 competition or engage in any practice, tryout, workout, or other 42 physical activity associated with the student's candidacy for an interscholastic athletic team until the results of the medical 43 44 evaluation have been received and approved by the school.
