13	dwelling because of race, color, national origin, sex, or
14	religion, and the act was amended in 1988 to include the bases
15	of disability and familial status, and
16	WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban
17	Development has proclaimed April as "National Fair Housing
18	Month," launching awareness campaigns to commemorate the
19	historical passage of this landmark legislation, increasing the
20	public's understanding of the many protections of the Civil
21	Rights Act, and encouraging communities to remember and
22	celebrate more than 45 years of housing successes, and
23	WHEREAS, because government and private entities may pursue
24	certain practices that could have a disproportionately harmful
25	effect on minorities protected by the Fair Housing Act of 1968,
26	the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development
27	recently issued regulations endorsing the use of "disparate
28	impact" standards that will serve as a powerful tool in
29	promoting fair housing opportunities, encouraging meaningful
