Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 253.7827, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

253.7827 Transportation and utility crossings of greenways lands.-

(3) Furthermore, the Legislature recognizes the needs expressed by Marion County to provide for the southerly extension of Sixtieth Avenue between State Road 200 and Interstate 75 and for the extension to cross the greenways lands to allow for the orderly growth and development of Marion County. Right-of-way for this extension across greenways lands shall be designed to mitigate the impacts to the extent practical, and the value of such lands shall be paid based on fair market value or, at the option of Marion County, the value can be subtracted from the amount of reimbursement due the
