(5) If, when reviewing form certifications submitted by an insurer, the office finds evidence of noncompliant forms for any personal lines insurance product or products, the office may, by order, suspend the authority of the insurer to file forms for such insurance products for up to 18 months and shall immediately notify the presiding officers of the Legislature and the Financial Services Commission. Upon review, the office may extend the order for up to an additional 18 months.
