1 A bill to be entitled

An act relating to other-personal-services employment; defining the term "other-personal-services employee"; authorizing the governing body of a county to employ other-personal-services employees; providing conditions; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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- Section 1. Other-personal-services employment; counties.—
- (1) As used in this section, the term "other-personal-services employee" means a temporary employee of the governing body of a county.
- (2) The governing body of a county may employ a qualified individual in other-personal-services employment. For each other-personal-services employee, the governing body of a county shall:
- (a) Maintain employee records identifying, at a minimum, the person employed, the hire date, the type of other-personal-services employment, and the number of hours worked per week.
- (b) Determine the appropriate rate of pay and ensure that all payments are in compliance with the federal Fair Labor

 Standards Act of 1938, as amended, 29 U.S.C. ss. 201 et seq., and applicable state law.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
