2	A memorial to the Congress of the United States,													
3	urging Congress to repeal all taxes on income and													
4	enact a national retail sales tax as specified in H.R.													
5	25, the Fair Tax Act of 2011.

7	WHEREAS, our Founding Fathers, being mindful that history													
8	has demonstrated that income taxes give government too much													
9	power over citizens, specifically forbade such taxes in the													
10	Constitution of the United States, and													
11	WHEREAS, Alexander Hamilton wrote in the Federalist No. 21													
12	that "it is a signal advantage of taxes on articles of													
13	consumption, that they contain in their own nature a security													
14	against excess," and													
15	WHEREAS, the current income tax system requires individual													
16	taxpayers to prepare annual tax returns using many complicated													
17	forms, causing innocent errors that are heavily punished, and													
18	WHEREAS, the current income tax system actually penalizes													
19	marriage, and													
20	WHEREAS, the federal income tax:													
21	(1) Retards economic growth and has reduced the standard													
22	of living of the American public;													
23	(2) Impedes the international competiveness of United													
24	States industry;													
25	(3) Reduces savings and investment in the United States by													
26	taxing income multiple times;													
27	(4) Slows the capital formation necessary for real wages													
28	to steadily increase;													
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HM 59 2013 29 (5) Lowers productivity; 30 Imposes unacceptable and unnecessary administrative (6) and compliance costs on individual and business taxpayers; 31 32 (7)Is unfair and inequitable; 33 (8) Unnecessarily intrudes upon the privacy and civil 34 rights of United States citizens; 35 Hides the true costs of government by embedding taxes (9) 36 in the costs of everything that Americans buy; 37 Is not being complied with at satisfactory levels (10)38 and, therefore, raises the tax burden on law-abiding citizens; 39 and Impedes upward social mobility, and 40 (11)41 WHEREAS, federal payroll taxes, including social security 42 and Medicare payroll taxes and self-employment taxes: 43 Raise the cost of employment; (1)44 (2)Destroy jobs and cause unemployment; and 45 (3) Have a disproportionately adverse impact on lower-46 income Americans, and 47 WHEREAS, the federal estate and gift taxes: 48 Force family business and farms to be sold by the (1)49 family in order to pay taxes; 50 (2)Discourage capital formation and entrepreneurship; 51 Foster the continued dominance of large enterprises (3) over small family owned companies and farms; and 52 53 Impose unacceptably high tax-planning costs on small (4) 54 business and farms, and 55 WHEREAS, a broad-based national sales tax on goods and 56 services purchased for final consumption: Page 2 of 4

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57 Is similar in many respects to the sales and use taxes (1)58 that are authorized in 45 of the 50 states; Will promote savings and investment; 59 (2)60 (3) Will promote fairness; 61 (4) Will promote economic growth; Will raise the standard of living; 62 (5) 63 (6) Will enhance productivity and international 64 competiveness; Will reduce administrative burdens on the American 65 (7)66 taxpayer; 67 (8) Will improve upward social mobility; and 68 (9) Will respect the privacy interests and civil rights of 69 taxpayers, and 70 WHEREAS, Congress should consider when implementing the 71 administration of a national sales tax that: 72 (1) Most of the practical experience in administering 73 sales taxes is found at the state level; 74 (2)It is desirable to harmonize federal and state 75 collection and enforcement efforts to the maximum extent 76 possible; 77 It is sound tax administration policy to foster (3) 78 administration and collection of the federal sales tax at the 79 state level in return for a reasonable administration fee to the states; and 80 81 (4)A business that must collect and remit taxes should 82 receive reasonable compensation for the cost of doing so, and 83 WHEREAS, the 16th Amendment to the United States 84 Constitution should be repealed, NOW, THEREFORE, Page 3 of 4

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85 86 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 87 88 That the Legislature of the State of Florida, with all due 89 respect, does hereby urge the United States Congress to enact H.R. 25, the Fair Tax Act of 2011, which eliminates the personal 90 91 income tax, the alternative minimum tax, the inheritance tax, 92 the gift tax, the capital gains tax, the corporate income tax, 93 the self-employment tax, and the employee and employer payroll tax and replaces them with a national retail sales tax. 94 95 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be 96 dispatched to the President of the United States, to the 97 President of the United States Senate, to the Speaker of the 98 United States House of Representatives, and to each member of 99 the Florida delegation to the United States Congress.

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
