Section 54. Paragraph (e) of subsection (5) of section 409.175, Florida Statutes, is amended to read

409.175 Licensure of family foster homes, residential child-caring agencies, and child-placing agencies; public records exemption.-

(5)

- (e) The department shall not adopt rules which:
- 1. Interfere with a caregiver's authority to use the reasonable and prudent parent standard, as defined in s.



39.4091(2)(c), as created by chapter 2013-21, Laws of Florida, to select a child care provider for the caregiver's foster child, including a child care provider that is exempt from licensure under s. 402.316, if the child care provider is accredited by an accrediting association that has written accreditation standards that meet or exceed the state's licensing requirements under s. 402.305, s. 402.3131, or s. 402.313 and require at least one onsite visit to the child care provider before accreditation is granted and complies with the reporting requirements of the Rilya Wilson Act,s 39.604; or

2. Interfere with the free exercise of religion or which regulate religious instruction or teachings in any child-caring or child-placing home or agency. +
