If any of the reopeners in s. 376.82(3)(b)-(d) apply, is responsible for brownfield site rehabilitation and who fails to 15 16 comply with the requirements or timeframes of the brownfield 17 site rehabilitation agreement or fails to comply with applicable

timeframes pursuant to department rules;

- e. Caused the contamination that is the subject of the brownfield site rehabilitation agreement; or
- f. Is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be the mere continuation or alter ego of the person identified in sub-subparagraph e. under successor liability principles under applicable law.
