Section 2. Subsection (6) of section 402.301, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

402.301 Child care facilities; legislative intent and declaration of purpose and policy.-It is the legislative intent to protect the health, safety, and well-being of the children of the state and to promote their emotional and intellectual



development and care. Toward that end:

(6) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, it is further the intent of the Legislature that membership organizations affiliated with national organizations which do not provide child care as defined in s. 402.302, whose primary purpose is providing activities that contribute to the development of good character, after school care and delinquency prevention programs which are operated 5 days a week or more, are facility or school based or good sportsmanship or to the education or cultural development of minors in this state, which charge only a nominal annual membership fee, which are not for profit, and which are certified by their national associations as being in compliance with the association's minimum standards and procedures shall not be considered child care facilities and therefore not subject to the licensing requirements or the minimum standards for child care facilities. However, upon request, such a facility shall show proof of one level 2 background screening per screened employee, their personnel shall not be required to be screened.
