An act relating to the Santa Rosa Island Authority, Escambia County; amending chapter 24500 (1947), Laws of Florida, as amended; revising the expense allowance for members of the authority; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (d) of section 3 of chapter 24500 (1947), Laws of Florida, as amended by chapters 75-366, 83-407, and 84-426, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

Section 3. (d) The members of the authority shall receive no compensation for their services, but shall be entitled to receive an expense allowance in attending to the business of the Santa Rosa Island Authority, in an amount to be determined by the Board of County Commissioners of Escambia County, not to exceed the sum of \$550 \$400 per month, plus up to an additional \$100 per month for the chair of the authority, including travel expenses for out of county travel to be paid from any funds of the authority. Four members shall constitute a quorum of the authority for the purpose of conducting its business and exercising its powers and for all other purposes. Action may be taken by the authority upon the affirmative vote of four of its members.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
