An act relating to public officers and employees; amending s. 112.326, F.S.; authorizing the electors of a political subdivision to impose additional or more stringent standards of conduct and disclosure requirements upon the political subdivision's officers and employees; requiring a local ethics agency or commission to establish certain procedures; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 112.326, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

112.326 Additional requirements by political subdivisions

and agencies not prohibited.—Nothing in This part does not prohibit the electors or act shall prohibit the governing body of a any political subdivision, by ordinance, or agency, by rule, from imposing upon its own officers and employees additional or more stringent standards of conduct and disclosure requirements than those specified in this part, if provided that those standards of conduct and disclosure requirements do not otherwise conflict with the provisions of this part. Procedures of a local ethics agency or commission governing complaints and investigations shall conform with procedures established under

s. 112.324.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
