(b) For vessels on All waters not outside of such
established lines of demarcation, the Inland Navigational Rules
Act of 1980, 33 C.F.R. parts 83-90, as amended, through October

143 <u>(42) (38)</u> "Unclaimed vessel" means <u>an</u> any undocumented 144 vessel, including its machinery, rigging, and accessories, which 145 is in the physical possession of a any marina, garage, or repair

156 <u>(44) (40)</u> "Waters of this state" means any navigable waters 157 of the United States within the territorial limits of this 158 state, and the marginal sea adjacent to this state and the high 159 seas when navigated as a part of a journey or ride to or from 160 the shore of this state, and all the inland lakes, rivers, and 161 canals under the jurisdiction of this state.
