Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 903.047, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

903.047 Conditions of pretrial release.-

- (1) As a condition of pretrial release, whether such release is by surety bail bond or recognizance bond or in some other form, the defendant shall:
- (b) Refrain from any contact of any type with the victim, except through pretrial discovery pursuant to the Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure. An order of no contact shall be effective immediately upon the order of the court and enforceable prior to and through the time of release.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2014.
