14	Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 448.24, Florida							
15	Statutes, is amended to read:							
16	448.24 Duties and rights.—							
17	(2) A labor pool shall:							
18	(a) Compensate day laborers for work performed using any							
19	of the following methods, subject to the limitations of							
20	paragraph (b), selected by the labor pool:							
21	<u>1.</u> Cash <u>;, or</u>							
22	$\underline{2.}$ Commonly accepted negotiable instruments that are							
23	payable in cash, on demand at a financial institution, and							
24	without discount;							
25	3. Payroll debit card; or							
26	4. Electronic fund transfer to a financial institution							

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designated by the day laborer.

- (b) When compensating a day laborer:
- 1. Before the first pay period, provide notice to the day laborer of the method that the labor pool intends to use for payroll and the day laborer's options with respect to electing his or her payment method.
- 2. Authorize the day laborer to elect not to be paid by payroll debit card or electronic funds transfer.
- (c) If the labor pool selects payment by payroll debit card:
- 1. Offer the day laborer the option of payment by electronic funds transfer to a financial institution designated by the day laborer.
- 2. Provide the day laborer with a list, including the address, of each business within close proximity to the labor pool that provides the ability to withdraw the contents of the payroll debit card without a fee.
- (d) (b) Compensate day laborers at or above the minimum wage, in conformance with the provision of s. 448.01. In no event shall any deductions, other than those permitted by federal or state law, bring the worker's pay below minimum wage for the hours worked.
  - (e) (c) Comply with all requirements of chapter 440.
- $\underline{\text{(f)}}$  Insure any motor vehicle owned or operated by the labor hall and used for the transportation of workers pursuant to Florida Statutes.

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(h) (f) Provide each worker with an annual earnings summary within a reasonable period of time after the end of the preceding calendar year, but no later than February 1.
