Senator Smith moved the following:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

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Between lines 239 and 240

insert:

Section 4. Subsection (5) is added to section 403.709,

Florida Statutes, to read:

403.709 Solid Waste Management Trust Fund; use of waste tire fees.—There is created the Solid Waste Management Trust Fund, to be administered by the department.

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(5) (a) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a solid waste landfill closure account is established within the Solid Waste



- 12 Management Trust Fund to provide funding for the closing and 13 long-term care of solid waste management facilities. The 14 department may use funds from the account to contract with a 15 third party for the closing and long-term care of a solid waste 16 management facility if: 17 1. The facility has or had a department permit to operate 18 the facility; 19 2. The permittee provided proof of financial assurance for 20
 - closure in the form of an insurance certificate;
 - 3. The facility is deemed to be abandoned or was ordered to close by the department;
 - 4. Closure is accomplished in substantial accordance with a closure plan approved by the department; and
 - 5. The department has written documentation that the insurance company issuing the closure insurance policy will provide or reimburse the funds required to complete closing and long-term care of the facility.
 - (b) The department shall deposit the funds received from the insurance company as reimbursement for the costs of or longterm care of the facility into the solid waste landfill closure account.

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An act relating to waste; amending s. 376.78, F.S.; revising legislative intent with regard to community revitalization in certain areas; amending s. 376.80,

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F.S.; revising procedures for designation of brownfield areas by local governments; providing procedures for adoption of a resolution; providing requirements for notice and public hearings; authorizing local governments to use a term other than "brownfield area" when naming such areas; amending s. 376.82, F.S.; providing an exemption from liability for property damage for entities that execute and implement certain brownfield site rehabilitation agreements; providing for applicability; amending s. 403.709, F.S.; establishing a solid waste landfill closure account within the Solid Waste Management Trust Fund; authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to use funds to contract with certain parties; requiring the department to deposit certain funds into the solid waste landfill closure account; providing an effective date.
