(1) (a) Upon application to the department on or before January 31 of each year, a person who is licensed to conduct public sales of thoroughbred horses under s. 535.01 and who has conducted thoroughbred horse sales for at least 8 days at a permanent sales facility in this state for at least 3

consecutive years shall be issued a license under this section to conduct intertrack wagering at such facility.

- (b) Only one license may be issued under this subsection.
- (2) If more than one application is submitted for such license, the department shall issue the license to the applicant demonstrating superior capabilities, as measured by the length of time the applicant has been conducting thoroughbred horse sales within this state or elsewhere, the applicant's total volume of thoroughbred horse sales within this state or elsewhere, the length of time the applicant has maintained a permanent thoroughbred sales facility in this state, and the quality of the facility.
  - (3) An applicant must comply with ss. 551.029 and 551.034.
- (4) The applicant that receives a license shall be considered a guest track under this chapter.
