

HB 485, Engrossed 1

An act relating to the Santa Rosa Island Authority, Escambia County; amending chapter 24500 (1947), Laws of Florida, as amended; revising the amounts authorized to be paid as an allowance for members of the authority; providing an effective date.

A bill to be entitled

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (d) of section 3 of chapter 24500, Laws of Florida, 1947, as amended by chapter 84-426, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

Section 3. (d) The members of the authority shall only receive as no compensation a monthly for their services, but shall be entitled to receive an expense allowance for in attending to the business of the Santa Rosa Island Authority, in an amount to be determined by the Board of County Commissioners of Escambia County, not to exceed the monthly sum of \$550 \$400 per member month, plus up to an additional \$100 per month for the chair of the authority, including travel expenses for out of county travel to be paid from any funds of the authority. Four members shall constitute a quorum of the authority for the purpose of conducting its business and exercising its powers and for all other purposes. Action may be taken by the authority upon the affirmative vote of four of its members.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
