- (1) A person may not sell or provide to a consumer an alcoholic beverage that is intended for human consumption and is in powdered form.
- (2) A person who violates subsection (1) commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. A person who violates subsection (1)

after having been previously convicted of such an offense within the past 5 years commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

- (3) A manufacturer licensed under the Beverage Law may manufacture and possess an alcoholic beverage in a powdered form. A licensed manufacturer may sell or otherwise transport alcohol in a powdered form to a licensed manufacturer or licensed distributor in this state, an entity authorized to possess powdered alcohol pursuant to subsection (6), or an entity in a jurisdiction outside of this state where the possession of powdered alcohol is not prohibited under the laws and regulations of that jurisdiction.
- (4) A licensed manufacturer, its agent or employee, or a common carrier acting on behalf of the licensed manufacturer, may possess powdered alcohol in this state for transport into, through, or out of the state. A licensed manufacturer may purchase, acquire, or otherwise possess alcohol in a powdered form. A licensed manufacturer may use powdered alcohol to manufacture an alcoholic beverage that may be sold in this state, so long as the alcoholic beverage is not sold or provided to consumers in a powdered form.
- (5) A licensed distributor may purchase or possess powdered alcohol in this state, so long as the powdered alcohol is not sold or provided to consumers or vendors in this state.
