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A bill to be entitled

An act relating to students with disabilities; amending s. 1003.5716, F.S.; requiring occupational skills training be incorporated into an individual education plan for students with disabilities; providing minimum requirements; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Present subsections (2) through (4) of section 1003.5716, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as subsections (3) through (5), respectively, a new subsection (2) is added to that section, and present subsection (3) of that section is amended, to read:

1003.5716 Transition to postsecondary education and career opportunities.—All students with disabilities who are 3 years of age to 21 years of age have the right to a free, appropriate public education. As used in this section, the term "IEP" means individual education plan.

(2) In addition to the requirements of subsection (1), a student with a disability shall have occupational skills training incorporated into his or her IEP to the greatest extent practicable. At a minimum, the IEP must provide for:

(a) Completion of an initial oral assessment to evaluate occupational skills and abilities in grade 8.

(b) Continued development of occupational skills and abilities throughout high school, including opportunities to participate in externship programs with potential employers.

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(c) Completion of a final oral assessment and interview in grade 12 to facilitate appropriate job placement with potential employers upon graduation.

 $\underline{(4)}$  (3) Any change in the IEP for the goals specified in subsection  $\underline{(3)}$  (2) must be approved by the parent and is subject to verification for appropriateness by an independent reviewer selected by the parent as provided in s. 1003.572.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
