- (a) To participate in the program, an individual must register with the local law enforcement agency on an application form or in an electronic format prescribed by the local law enforcement agency and provide a primary and secondary telephone number to be used for verification calls.
- (b) Under the program, alarm monitoring personnel, upon receiving an alarm signal, must immediately notify the local law enforcement agency of the alarm signal and then contact the primary and secondary telephone numbers on file.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
