An act relating to driving safety; creating s. 316.306, F.S.; prohibiting the use of cellular telephones and other electronic communications devices by drivers in a school zone or school crossing or on school district property; providing penalties; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 316.306, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

316.306 Use of cellular telephone or electronic communications device in school zone; prohibition.-

- (1) A person may not operate a motor vehicle in a legally posted school zone or designated school crossing or on school district property while using any type of cellular telephone or electronic communications device or while sending or reading data on such a device for the purpose of communication, including, but not limited to, texting, e-mailing, and instant messaging. As used in this section, the term "electronic communications device" means a device that is designed or intended to receive or transmit voice, text, or character-based messages; access or store data; or connect to the Internet or a communications service as defined in s. 812.15.
- (2) A person who violates this section commits a noncriminal traffic infraction, punishable as a moving violation as provided in chapter 318.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2015.
