At a minimum, the report shall include the criteria used to select participants, the number of participants, the age of the participants, the nature of the participants' special needs, the number of participants who elope, the amount of time taken to rescue such participants following elopement, and the outcome of any rescue attempts. The final report shall also provide recommendations for modification or continued implementation of the project.
