15 (a) Notwithstanding s. 45, chapter 2008-176, Laws of  
 16 Florida, as amended by s. 21, chapter 2010-223 and s. 45,  
 17 chapter 2014-216, Laws of Florida, the department shall develop

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18 a Pan-Hellenic Sorority and Fraternity license plate for each of  
19 the following sororities and fraternities, subject to s.  
20 320.08053, as provided in this section:

21 1. Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc.

22 a. The department shall retain all annual use fees from  
23 the sale of such plates until all startup costs for developing  
24 and issuing plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the annual  
25 use fees from the sale of the plate shall be distributed as  
26 follows:

27 (1) 10 percent shall be distributed to the Florida  
28 Federation of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity Foundation, Inc., a  
29 charitable, not-for-profit organization under s. 501(c)(3) of  
30 the Internal Revenue Code registered with the Department of  
31 Agriculture and Consumer Services and incorporated in Florida,  
32 strictly for marketing of the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc.  
33 license plate.

34 (2) 85 percent shall be distributed to the Florida  
35 Federation of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity Foundation to promote  
36 community awareness and action through educational, economic,  
37 and cultural service activities.

38 (3) 5 percent shall be distributed to the United Negro  
39 College Fund to be used for college scholarships for Florida  
40 residents attending Historically Black Colleges and  
41 Universities.

42 2. Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc.

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43 a. The department shall retain all annual use fees from  
44 the sale of such plates until all startup costs for developing  
45 and issuing plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the annual  
46 use fees from the sale of the plate shall be distributed as  
47 follows:

48 (1) 10 percent shall be distributed to Omega Friendship  
49 Foundation, Inc., a charitable, not-for-profit organization  
50 under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code registered with  
51 the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and  
52 incorporated in Florida, strictly for marketing of the Omega Psi  
53 Phi Fraternity, Inc. license plate.

54 (2) 85 percent shall be distributed to the Omega  
55 Friendship Foundation, Inc. to promote community awareness and  
56 action through educational, economic, and cultural service  
57 activities.

58 (3) 5 percent shall be distributed to the United Negro  
59 College Fund to be used for college scholarships for Florida  
60 residents attending Historically Black Colleges and  
61 Universities.

62 3. Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc.

63 a. The department shall retain all annual use fees from  
64 the sale of such plates until all startup costs for developing  
65 and issuing plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the annual  
66 use fees from the sale of the plate shall be distributed as  
67 follows:

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68 (1) 10 percent shall be distributed to Southern Province  
69 Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., a charitable, not-for-profit  
70 organization under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code  
71 registered with the Department of Agriculture and Consumer  
72 Services and incorporated in Florida, strictly for marketing of  
73 the Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. license plate.

74 (2) 85 percent shall be distributed to the Southern  
75 Province Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. to promote community  
76 awareness and action through educational, economic, and cultural  
77 service activities.

78 (3) 5 percent shall be distributed to the United Negro  
79 College Fund to be used for college scholarships for Florida  
80 residents attending Historically Black Colleges and  
81 Universities.

82 4. Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc.

83 a. The department shall retain all annual use fees from  
84 the sale of such plates until all startup costs for developing  
85 and issuing plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the annual  
86 use fees from the sale of the plate shall be distributed as  
87 follows:

88 (1) 10 percent shall be distributed to TMB Charitable  
89 Foundation, Inc., a charitable, not-for-profit organization  
90 under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code registered with  
91 the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and  
92 incorporated in Florida, strictly for marketing of the Phi Beta  
93 Sigma Fraternity, Inc. license plate.

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94 (2) 85 percent shall be distributed to the TMB Charitable  
95 Foundation, Inc. to promote community awareness and action  
96 through educational, economic, and cultural service activities.

97 (3) 5 percent shall be distributed to the United Negro  
98 College Fund to be used for college scholarships for Florida  
99 residents attending Historically Black Colleges and  
100 Universities.

101 5. Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc.

102 a. The department shall retain all annual use fees from  
103 the sale of such plates until all startup costs for developing  
104 and issuing plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the annual  
105 use fees from the sale of the plate shall be distributed as  
106 follows:

107 (1) 10 percent shall be distributed to Florida Pearls,  
108 Inc., a charitable, not-for-profit organization under s.  
109 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code registered with the  
110 Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and incorporated  
111 in Florida, strictly for marketing of the Zeta Phi Beta  
112 Sorority, Inc. license plate.

113 (2) 85 percent shall be distributed to the Florida Pearls,  
114 Inc. to promote community awareness and action through  
115 educational, economic, and cultural service activities.

116 (3) 5 percent shall be distributed to the United Negro  
117 College Fund to be used for college scholarships for Florida  
118 residents attending Historically Black Colleges and  
119 Universities.

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120 6. Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.

121 a. The department shall retain all annual use fees from  
122 the sale of such plates until all startup costs for developing  
123 and issuing plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the annual  
124 use fees from the sale of the plate shall be distributed as  
125 follows:

126 (1) 10 percent shall be distributed to Delta Research and  
127 Educational Foundation, a charitable, not-for-profit  
128 organization under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code,  
129 strictly for marketing of the Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.  
130 license plate.

131 (2) 85 percent shall be distributed to the Delta Research  
132 and Educational Foundation to promote community awareness and  
133 action through educational, economic, and cultural service  
134 activities.

135 (3) 5 percent shall be distributed to the United Negro  
136 College Fund to be used for college scholarships for Florida  
137 residents attending Historically Black Colleges and  
138 Universities.

139 7. Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc.

140 a. The department shall retain all annual use fees from  
141 the sale of such plates until all startup costs for developing  
142 and issuing plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the annual  
143 use fees from the sale of the plate shall be distributed as  
144 follows:

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145 (1) 10 percent shall be distributed to Alpha Kappa Alpha  
146 Sorority Foundation, Inc., a charitable, not-for-profit  
147 organization under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code  
148 registered with the Department of Agriculture and Consumer  
149 Services and incorporated in Florida, strictly for marketing of  
150 the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. license plate.

151 (2) 85 percent shall be distributed to the Alpha Kappa  
152 Alpha Sorority Foundation, Inc. to promote community awareness  
153 and action through educational, economic, and cultural service  
154 activities.

155 (3) 5 percent shall be distributed to the United Negro  
156 College Fund to be used for college scholarships for Florida  
157 residents attending Historically Black Colleges and  
158 Universities.

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
