18	(e) A representative of law enforcement agencies, appointed
19	by the Florida Sheriffs Association.
20	(f) A member of the judiciary who regularly evaluates Baker
21	Act cases, appointed by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court.
22	(g) A public defender, appointed by the Florida Public
23	Defender Association.
24	(h) A state attorney, appointed by the Florida Prosecuting
25	Attorneys Association.
26	(i) Two physicians who provide care within a Baker Act
27	receiving facility. The Florida Medical Association and the
28	Florida Osteopathic Medical Association shall each appoint one
29	physician.
30	(j) A physician who regularly screens patients who meet
31	Baker Act criteria, appointed by the Florida College of
32	Emergency Physicians, and a physician assistant appointed by the
33	Florida Academy of Physician Assistants.
34	(k) A representative from a managing entity, appointed by
35	the Secretary of Children and Families.

- (n) An advanced registered nurse practitioner who works in a Baker Act receiving facility and who treats patients who meet Baker Act criteria, appointed by the Florida Nurses Association. (o) Two advanced registered nurse practitioners who are nationally certified in mental health, one appointed by the
 - Florida Association of Nurse Practitioners, and one appointed by the Florida Nurse Practitioner Network. (p) A psychologist licensed under chapter 490, Florida
 - Statutes, appointed by the Florida Psychological Association, and a mental health counselor appointed by the Florida Mental Health Counselors Association.
 - (q) A psychiatrist with experience in the Baker Act, appointed by the Florida Psychiatric Society.
