Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 265.111, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
  - 265.111 Capitol Complex; monuments.-
- (3) The Department of Management Services, in consultation with the Florida Historical Commission, shall set aside an area of the Capitol Complex, not including the State Capital Circle Office Complex, and dedicate a memorial garden on which authorized monuments shall be placed. The memorial garden must include a monument in remembrance of the 241 members of the United States Armed Forces who lost their lives on October 23, 1983, in Beirut, Lebanon.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
