1 House Resolution 2 A resolution designating March 17, 2015, as "FSU Day" in the State of Florida. 3 4 5 WHEREAS, the Tallahassee campus of Florida State University 6 is the oldest continuous site of higher education in Florida and 7 holds the state's first chapter of Phi Beta Kappa, which was 8 chartered in 1935, and 9 WHEREAS, in 2005, Florida State University was recognized, 10 again, as one of the nation's top research universities by being rated as a "Research University, Very High Research Activity" by 11 12 the Carnegie Foundation, and WHEREAS, Florida State University offers graduate and 13 undergraduate degrees in 332 programs within 17 independent 14 15 colleges and schools, taught by a faculty of 2,408 members, 16 which has included National Academy of Sciences members and 6 17 Nobel Laureates, and WHEREAS, one of the most academically accomplished freshman 18 19 classes in Florida State University history is at the forefront of the institution's exemplary accomplishments for the 2014-2015 20 academic year and, with an average GPA of 3.9, an average GPA of 21 22 4.4 among honors students, and a median SAT score of 1813, the nearly 6,200 freshmen elevated the university's academic 23 24 standing to new heights, and 25 WHEREAS, in 2002, the Florida State University College of
