A bill to be entitled

An act relating to animals confined in unattended motor vehicles; providing a short title; creating s. 828.075, F.S.; prohibiting a person from confining an animal in an unattended motor vehicle under certain circumstances; providing a criminal penalty; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Protecting Animal Welfare and Safety Act" or "P.A.W.S. Act."

Section 2. Section 828.075, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

828.075 Animals in unattended motor vehicles.—A person who intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly confines an animal in an unattended motor vehicle under conditions that endanger the health or well-being of the animal due to heat, cold, lack of adequate ventilation, lack of food or water, or other circumstances that could reasonably be expected to cause suffering, disability, or death of the animal commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
